



Data Management Case Study

Improved Data Quality and Consistency

Summary

In 2020, the Public Libraries of New Zealand (PLNZ), a public library advocacy association similar to the Public Library Association (PLA) or American Library Association (ALA) in the United States, implemented the Counting Opinions' LibPAS solution. Prior to 2020, PLNZ attempted to collect data across more than 60 libraries via a shared Excel spreadsheet. Moving annual data collection efforts to LibPAS continues to result in improved data quality and consistency and high reporting rates across New Zealand public libraries.

PLNZ and member libraries continue to be empowered by the LibPAS solution. Data literacy continues to grow and LibPAS informs and supports more effective data-driven advocacy for New Zealand's public libraries. PLNZ will be incorporating financial, cultural, environmental, and social well-being measures in LibPAS and looks forward to working with Counting Opinions in this effort.
